After 30 years of working in the archives of Eastern Europe, Miriam is in the midst of the arduous task of indexing the literally thousands of pages of documents she has acquired and translated for her books, her website and research clients.

Currently, she has more than 300 separate document collections with 3 million surnames from: Belarus, Lithuania, Moldova/Bessarabia, Poland, Romania and Ukraine (and Galicia)

In the **firs**t upload to the new database, there are 150 separate document collections with 1 million surnames. **Additions are daily.**

For those of you who are familiar with Miriam's work, this is the latest chapter in a career that has literally opened doors to the archives of Poland & the former U.S.S.R. On June 28, 1991, "The Jewish Week" newspaper in New York City headlined an article about Miriam as follows: "The Genealogist Who Lifted the Archival Iron Curtain."

Surname Searches are possible as follows:

- Standard surname search of documents in Latin letters
- OCR search of business directories, telephone books and name-lists in Cyrillic letters (you do not need to know Cyrillic [(Russian] to do this search)

During 25+ years of traveling in Eastern Europe, I have acquired a significant number of detailed "town" maps from various localities, including small towns and villages. Most of these maps were created by the local town architect and given to me as a "present" by the local Mayor.

I received 75 maps of these maps (aka JOG maps) in the mid/late 1980s as a "gift" from someone working in Washington D.C. Recently, I consulted a colleague at the Geography & Map Division at the Library of Congress about these maps and was told the following:

"The Library of Congress routinely received these Joint Operations Graphic maps as part of a government deposit agreement; and the LC should have a virtually complete set. Also, JOG maps were U.S. government issued, in which case they are in the public domain and can be reproduced freely. So yes, you can digitize and put them up for all to see."

NOTE: The JOG maps are being scanned now and should be upon on the RTRF website in the next 4-6 weeks.
